(b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full. (Surname in BLOCK CAPITALS).

(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of the HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.

(d) State exact national status. eg. a British Subject by Birth or a British Subject by naturalisation. British protected Person, &c. IN THE CASE OF A BRITISH SUBJECT BY NATURALISATION the applicant's certificate of Naturalisation must be forwarded with the Declaration.

(e) Wife—children should be only included or

(f) The words in brackets to be struck out and initialled in cases where the applicant has no previous Travel Permit in his possession.

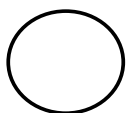
(g) The words in brackets to be struck out if the applicant has not previously held a Travel Permit.

(h) Signature. The applicant must also write a specimen of his signature in the space below marked.\*\*

(i) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz:—
